

EXERCISE TWO

CSS STYLING & GOOGLE FONTS

1. Open a new .css document in your text editor of choice.
2. Before you begin, save the file in your site root folder and name it "stylesheet.css".
3. Attach the stylesheet to "index.html" by referencing with a link tag in the head element:
`<link href="stylesheet.css" type="text/css" rel="stylesheet">`

4. Apply **all** of the following styles to the html elements in your webpage:

font-family

font-size (only use em units)

color (only use RGB or Hex)

line-height (only use % or em units) text-align

text-decoration

text-transform

list-style-type

width (only use %)

height (only use %)

a:link

a:visited

a:hover

background-color (only use RGB or Hex) background-image

background-repeat

5. Customize your website by adding a web font using Google Fonts.

Go to google.com/fonts then select the font family you wish to use. Let's pretend you chose Roboto...

Add the code to the head of your html page that is generated for you by Google (here is an example):

```
<link href="https://fonts.googleapis.com/css?family=Roboto"
rel="stylesheet">
```

Change the font in your css document using (here is an example):

```
font-family: 'Roboto', sans-serif;
```
