

EXERCISE FIVE

SKELETON FRAMEWORK

Practice using Skeleton Framework by recreating your sandbox with it.

Remember Skeleton is mobile up, so the css is for the mobile version and then the media queries are for anything larger than mobile. If everything is based upon percentages and fluid, it should be easy.

1. Start over fresh and clean. You are still required to have links to your projects and process, an image, heading(s), and paragraph text as a minimum.
2. Download Skeleton: <http://getskeleton.com/>
3. Add these files in your site root folder (**skeleton.css**, **normalize.css**, and your own external **css stylesheet**) and link to them in the head of your html document.
4. Sketch out and label a wireframe of boxes for your content, so you know how to structure your html.
5. Restructure your html using containers, rows, and columns – referencing the provided css selectors in the skeleton.css file.
6. Customize the styles of your page through your own additional stylesheet. You can also add to the media queries they have set up for you to change the design for anything larger than mobile.
